



## International Student Admissions Process

**Schoolhouse Preparatory is a Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP)-certified school and eligible to enroll F-1 students in the United States.**

### **Requirements:**

- ✓ Student must reside with a parent or guardian in Miami, Florida while attending Schoolhouse Preparatory.
- ✓ Student must have proficiency in the English Language.
- ✓ Schoolhouse Preparatory will not admit international students with a terminated I-20 Visa.

### **Application Process:**

**Documents in a language other than Spanish must be translated to English.**

1. Complete the International Student Online Application  
[www.schoolhouseprep.com/international-students.html](http://www.schoolhouseprep.com/international-students.html)
2. Submit an **ORIGINAL TRANSCRIPT** from 8<sup>th</sup> grade to present grade.
3. Submit a copy of the student's Passport.
4. Submit a copy of the student's birth certificate
5. Submit the most recent standardized test scores (if available).
6. Submit 2 Letters of Recommendation from present teachers.
7. Final decision on admission will be determined after all documents have been received and reviewed.
8. I-20 Visa will be issued once student has been granted admission to Schoolhouse Preparatory. Upon receiving the I-20 forms, the Parent/Guardian must schedule the interview at the American Embassy and is responsible for paying the I-901 Fee and the American Embassy fee. Visit <https://studyinthestates.dhs.gov/> for more information on paying fees and scheduling the appointment at the embassy.
9. Schoolhouse Preparatory does not guarantee that a student will be approved for the F-1 Visa by the American embassy.

**Once the student is granted the F-1 Visa by the American Embassy, the following documents must be provided:**

- Official Final Transcript. Must be an original with the stamp of the issuing institution.
- Proof of immunization
- Copy of Power of Attorney signed by the Host Family
- Schoolhouse Preparatory Registration Form
